Group Discussion

1. Share a photo of your younger self. In what ways do you feel like a totally different person today—and why?
OR: What's something you used to be known for that doesn't define you anymore?
2. In Exodus 1:8–14, Israel's story faded and Pharaoh's voice defined them. What do you notice about how forgetting their story made them vulnerable to being redefined?
3. When Moses hears God call his name from the burning bush (Exodus 3:1–12), what stands out about how God speaks to Moses' fear and confusion about who he is?
4. In Exodus 12:3–13, the blood on the doorframe marked a choice. What does that action say about how identity is formed by the story people choose to trust and live out?
5. Looking at your own life, where do you notice competing voices shaping your identity? What would it look like this week to choose God's voice over the loudest one?

Prayer

God, thank You for being the One who sees, hears, and comes near to rescue, and for being faithful to keep Your promises even when we forget them.

We admit that there are voices we've listened to that have shaped us more than Your truth, and there are places where we've let fear, shame, or old stories define us. Would You lovingly reveal the voices that have been holding us captive and remind us who we are in You? Give us courage to choose Your voice of freedom today, and give us opportunities to keep telling the story of what You've done in our lives. Amen.
