Group Discussion

1. Think about a meaningful ritual in your life (a holiday tradition, family habit, etc.). Why do you think rituals often carry more meaning than ordinary actions?
2. In Book of Exodus 25:8, God tells Israel, “*Have them make a sanctuary for me, and I will dwell among them.*” What does this statement and the detailed instructions reveal about God’s heart and His desire for relationship with His people?
3. Many elements in the Tabernacle were made with **acacia wood covered in gold**, symbolizing humanity and divinity together. What might this imagery teach us about God’s plan to restore His relationship with humanity?
4. In Book of Exodus 25:30, God instructs that the Bread of the Presence be set before Him continually. What might this ongoing practice reveal about Israel’s relationship with God and their dependence on Him?
5. If the Tabernacle is a “map” of returning to God’s presence, which step in that journey do you sense God inviting you to focus on right now?
 1. Come Through the **Gate**: Surrender your life to Christ.
 2. Offer Your Life on the **Altar**: Die to the old self.
 3. Be **Washed** and Made New: Allow God to cleanse and renew your heart.
 4. Renew Your Mind with **Truth**: Replace lies with God’s truth.
 5. Practice His **Presence**: Build rhythms of prayer, Scripture, and worship.
 6. Step Through the **Veil**: Step into who God says you are.
 7. Live as an **Ambassador and Priest**: Represent Christ in the world.
